The usual course of shooting is eight rounds, but bring some extra just in case. Hawk and knife contests start immediately after the shooting. Cost for shooting is \$3. If you're staying for lunch, bring a dish to pass. After lunch we award prizes. This event is open to any safe shooter; you do not need to be club member. It's a great event to bring a guest. It's low-key, and a lot of fun!
